USE ANYWHERE IRC CLIENT

RedBox 1.0 is a use anywhere IRC client. With versions for Mac OS X and Windows (XP recommended), you can put it on a mini CD-r and carry it with you to use wherever you have access to a computer:

- Campus computer lab
- Friend's computer
- Internet Cafe
- Library
- etc...

Using RedBox

To use RedBox, simply double click the applications icon. You will be presented with a window asking for your preferred IRC server and username. Clicking *Ok* will connect you to the IRC server. Once you are connected, you will need only type

/join channel

Replacing ***channel*** with the channel of your choice.

For example, to access the Nitrogen Narcosis Software support channel, you would connect to irc.freenode.net, then type ***/join #NNSoftware***.
